I still need to find or purchase items for the 13 to 16 age group, both boys and girls and we usually have about 175 of this age group between our churches in Mexico. It costs approximately \$5.00 per person @ 175 = \$875 total for their gifts. This is the hardest group to prepare for as they are older. We still purchase toothpaste, toothbrushes, combs, washcloths, bar soap for each gift bag along with their "Christmas gift". It all has to be ready to assemble into the bags by November 5th.
