Next is electrical work and building a few kitchen cabinets and counter top. Thank you for helping us with this project. It will be a blessing to them for a long time. She is very dedicated to this work.

The first of March, Lorene, (mom) came down with pneumonia and was hospitalized a couple of days to get it all under control but she is now home recuperating, doing much better and taking her meds. It's critical because of her age of 97, but as you know, she has a strong constitution.

We continue receiving food and clothing and other things each month to give where needed and are very grateful for it. Things go from bad to worse in a lot of cases for them and it is a huge blessing.

The cartel picked up one of our pastor's son-in-law and the family was requested to pay ransom, which they did, then the next day the cartel came back and told them he would not be coming back. This is how serious it is in Mexico. Please pray for the family. It's a sad situation all around. Pray for the work, pray for our protection, pray for the Lord's will to be done in all of our work.
